March Program - Richard Stillman, Entertainer



Richard Stillman is a Broadway actor, musician, singer, tap dancer, and storyteller who plays the banjo, mandolin, ukulele, guitar, and bagpipes. He offers several multicultural bands and shows performed for children and adults alike.

His show, "The Spirit of Vaudeville," won the BEST CONCERT AWARD at the United Solo Theater Festival in NYC.

Richard holds a BA in Theatre from Dartmouth College, a performing artists in the schools certificate from Columbia University, and studied further at the American Musical and Dramatic Academy, with acting teacher Michael Howard and with vaudeville string musician, Roy Smeck.

Richard was featured on the premier episode of the PBS television series Shining Time Station and received critical acclaim for his performance in Lady Be Good at the Kennedy Center and the Goodspeed Opera House.

On Broadway, Richard played the Clerk of Oxford in Canterbury Tales & understudied Mummenschanz. He has also performed in regional theater, national tours and television. Mr. Stillman has played at the New Jersey Folk Festival, opened for Jim Henson and Kermit the Frog, and performs every year at the New Jersey Storytelling Festival as a musical storyteller.

For more than 20 years, Richard has toured his shows to adult communities, theatres, schools, and festivals. He has a musical theater company and a multicultural storytelling and music group. Mr. Stillman also performs as a musical entertainer, banjo player, ukulele player, mandolin player, concertina player, bagpiper, and storyteller.
