May Program - Richard Muti, Author



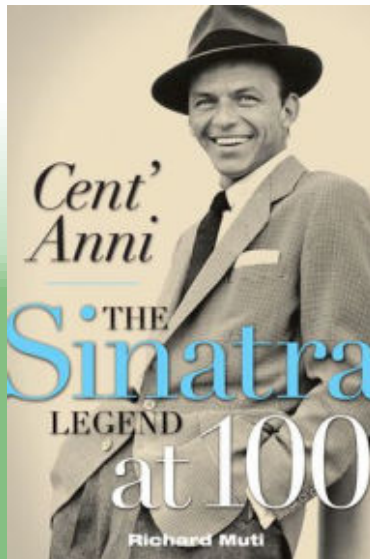
Richard Muti is a graduate of the United States Naval Academy, Harvard Business School and Rutgers Law School. He is a former Navy pilot, a former assistant Bergen County prosecutor and a former mayor of Ramsey, New Jersey, his hometown. He also served on the Ramsey Board of Education for six years and has taught at three New Jersey universities. Richard has more than 100 publishing credits, including six books and featured articles in New Jersey Monthly, The New York Times, New Jersey Lawyer, The Star-Ledger, and The Bergen Record.

Richard's latest book, Cent'Anni: The Sinatra Legend at 100, offers a comprehensive look at Frank Sinatra, perhaps the most acclaimed entertainer of the 20th century and a man whose personal demons often threatened to overtake the better angels of his nature. This

fascinating new Sinatra biography has been named an Award Finalist in the USA Book News Best Book competition and was selected by the New Jersey State Library and produced as an audio book for the blind and reading impaired. Former NJ Governor Jim Florio had this to say: "Richard Muti has thoroughly captured Frank Sinatra's complex nature – a mix of dogged determination, incomparable artistry, boundless generosity, and outright thuggishness," adding that Muti's book "ranks among the best biographies of New Jersey's most illustrious son."

Since the Sinatra biography's publication in late 2015, Richard has presented talks on his subject's life and career at more than 90 venues in four states, to audiences totaling in the thousands.

Among the groups who have enjoyed this program are more than three dozen Italian-American organizations, where Richard tailors his presentation to concentrate on Sinatra's Italian heritage.
